Poundmaker Cree Nation, Saskatchewan

Registration:

- Space is limited—please register early
- The fee is \$50 per day
- Payment options: upon arrival or by e-transfer to miyawata.films@gmail.com

Accommodation and Meals:

- Participants are responsible for their own accommodations and travel to and from the workshop
- Participants can **camp** in or around the Museum (access to water, washrooms, coffee maker, hot plate, and fridge; no access to shower or cooking facilities)
- Additional camping spots (rough, but safe and secure) are available at the Miyawata Culture site at Poundmaker Lake, about 5 km from the Museum
- There are two electrical outlets for **RV camping** at the Museum
- **Hotels and motels** are in North Battleford (about 70 km away) or in Cut Knife (about 15 km away)
- **Food** will be provided to participants throughout the day
- Snacks and drinks will be provided during the workshop times, and there will be a dinner break

Security and Policy:

- There is 24-hour security on the Poundmaker Cree Nation
- Due to the spiritual nature of Plains Indian Sign Language, we hope this is respected with a no alcohol or drugs policy
- We respect all races, creeds and genders, and we ask and will enforce that there be no jokes, comments or behaviour that makes anyone uncomfortable or feel threatened

- Please bring your own notebooks, writing materials, towels, and utensils (including cups and plates) in order to create less waste of resources.
